Working with the Greater London Authority (GLA), the London Legal Support Trust (LLST) and advice partners across London we've expanded our services and outreach in the community to support Londoners facing cost of living challenges.

We also work with, support and train community groups across London to offer "Advice First Aid"; building up their skills and knowlege to support communities and refer into advice where appropriate.

Our cost of living support includes advice and assistance with welfare benefits, debt, budgeting, energy, crisis grants and other local other schemes.

## **London Partnerships**

Partnership is key to everything we do. Our London partnerships include:

Debt Free London: We work in a London partnership of debt charities to provide debt advice for Londoners.

Food partnerships ("Food Roots"): We work with foodbanks and other food aid organisations in London, including working with health and food partners supporting schemes to buy food and milk (eg., NHS Healthy Start scheme).

Employment training advice programme: We work across London to upskill our service in employment rights advice so that we can tackke labour exploitation and poor employment practices.

Workforce programme ("London Propel"): We work with London Funders to find new ways of offering training and employment in advice work, especially from London communities who are under-represented, or have lived experience of advice issues.
